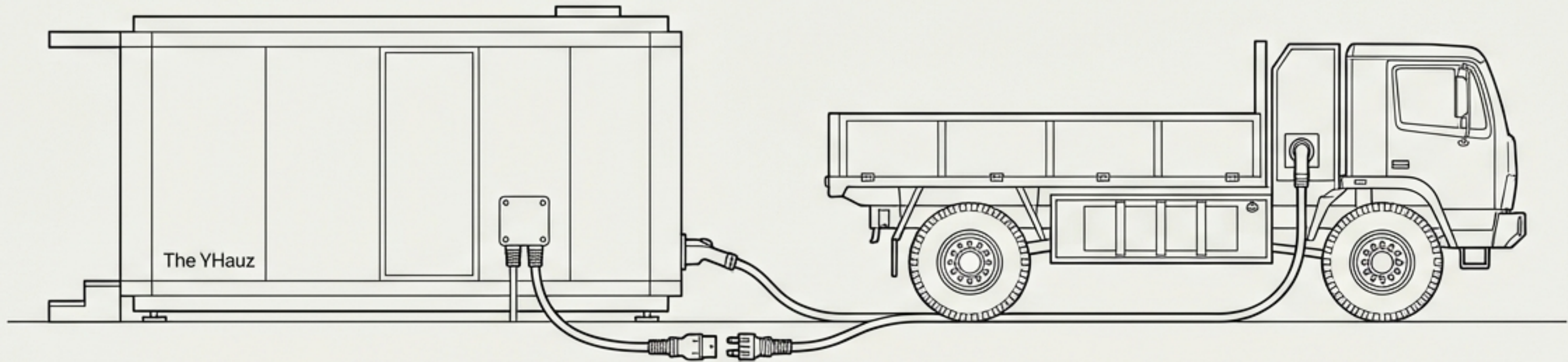

A Structural Shift, Not a Lifestyle Choice

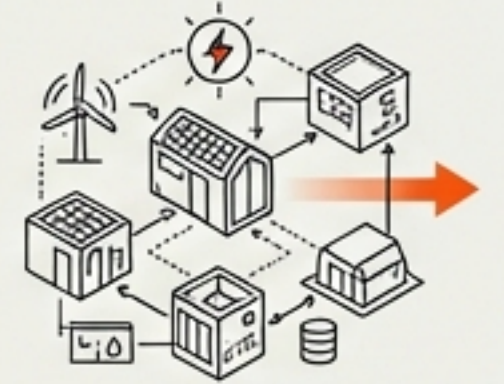

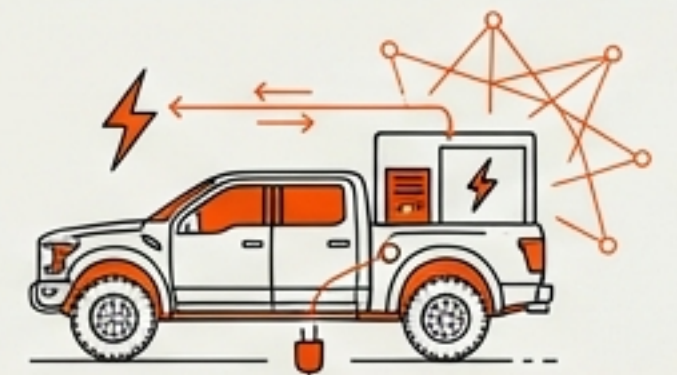

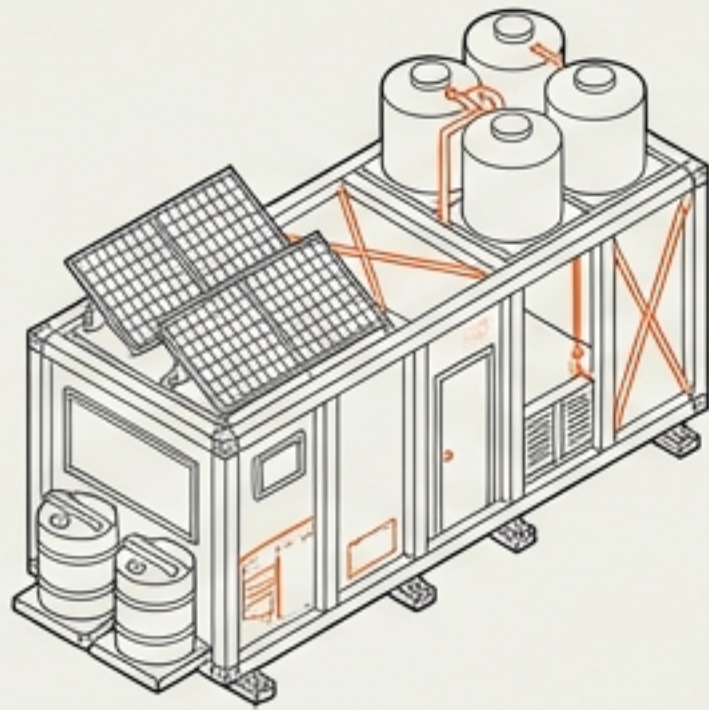
- A structural shift in how households are formed and sustained.

Off-grid YHauz combined with an EV truck creates a self-reliant household platform—a new frontier for living, working, and owning outside rent-extractive systems.



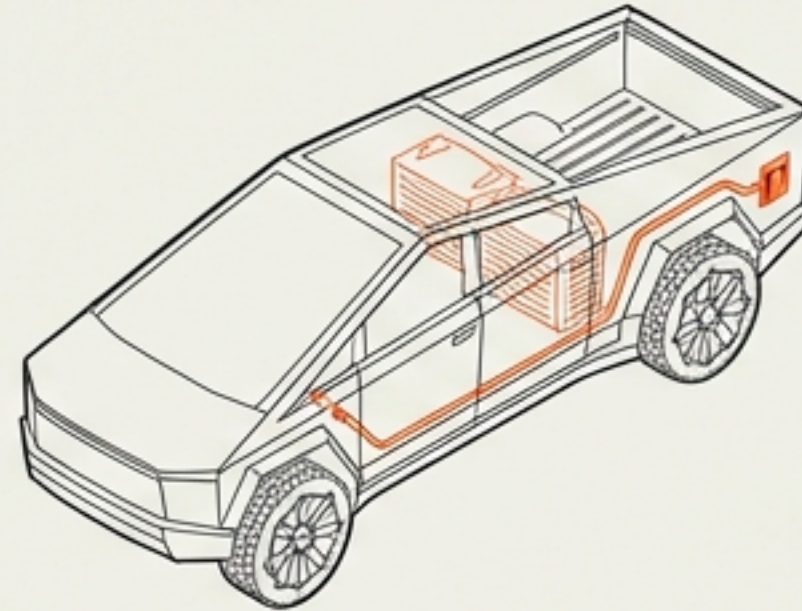
The New American Frontier Equation

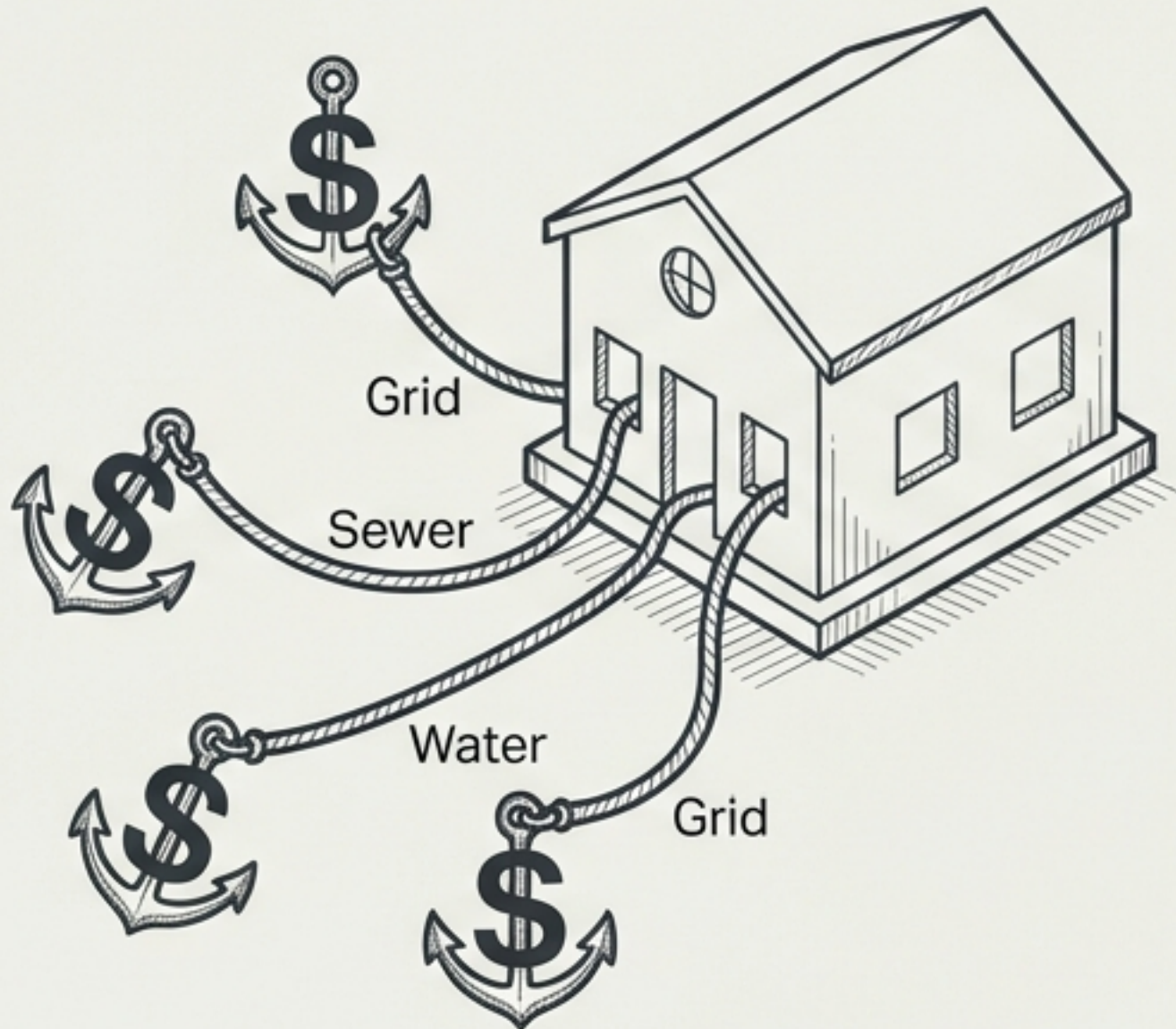

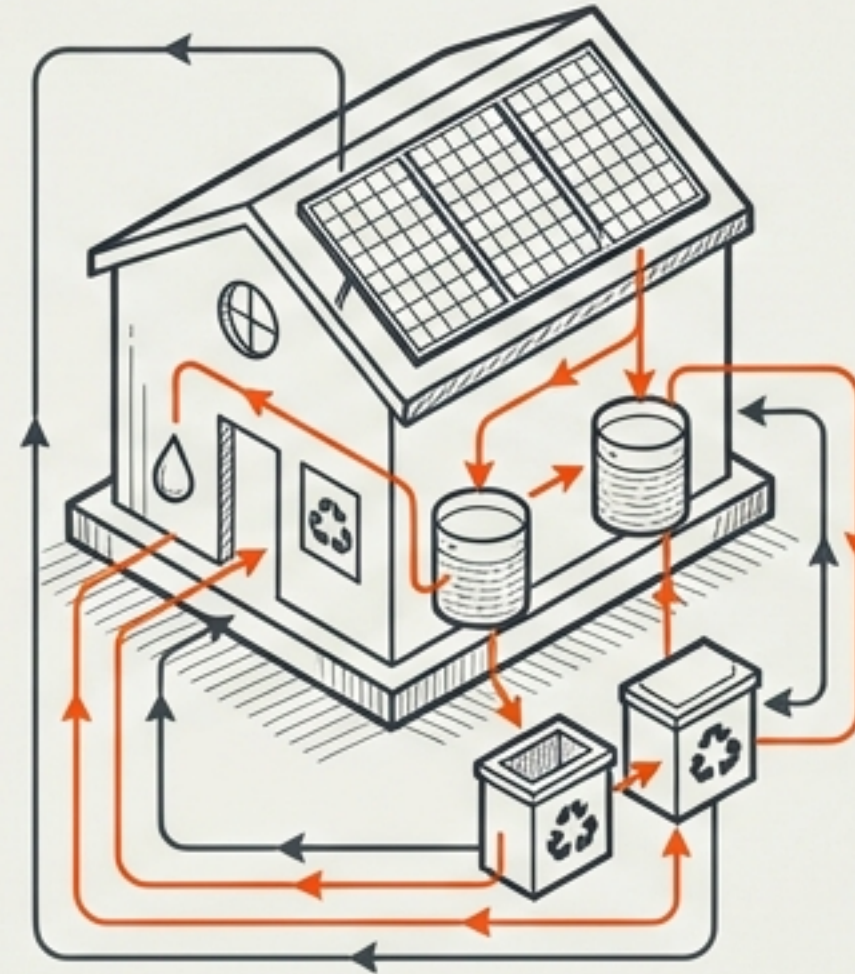
Independence is an Economic Asset

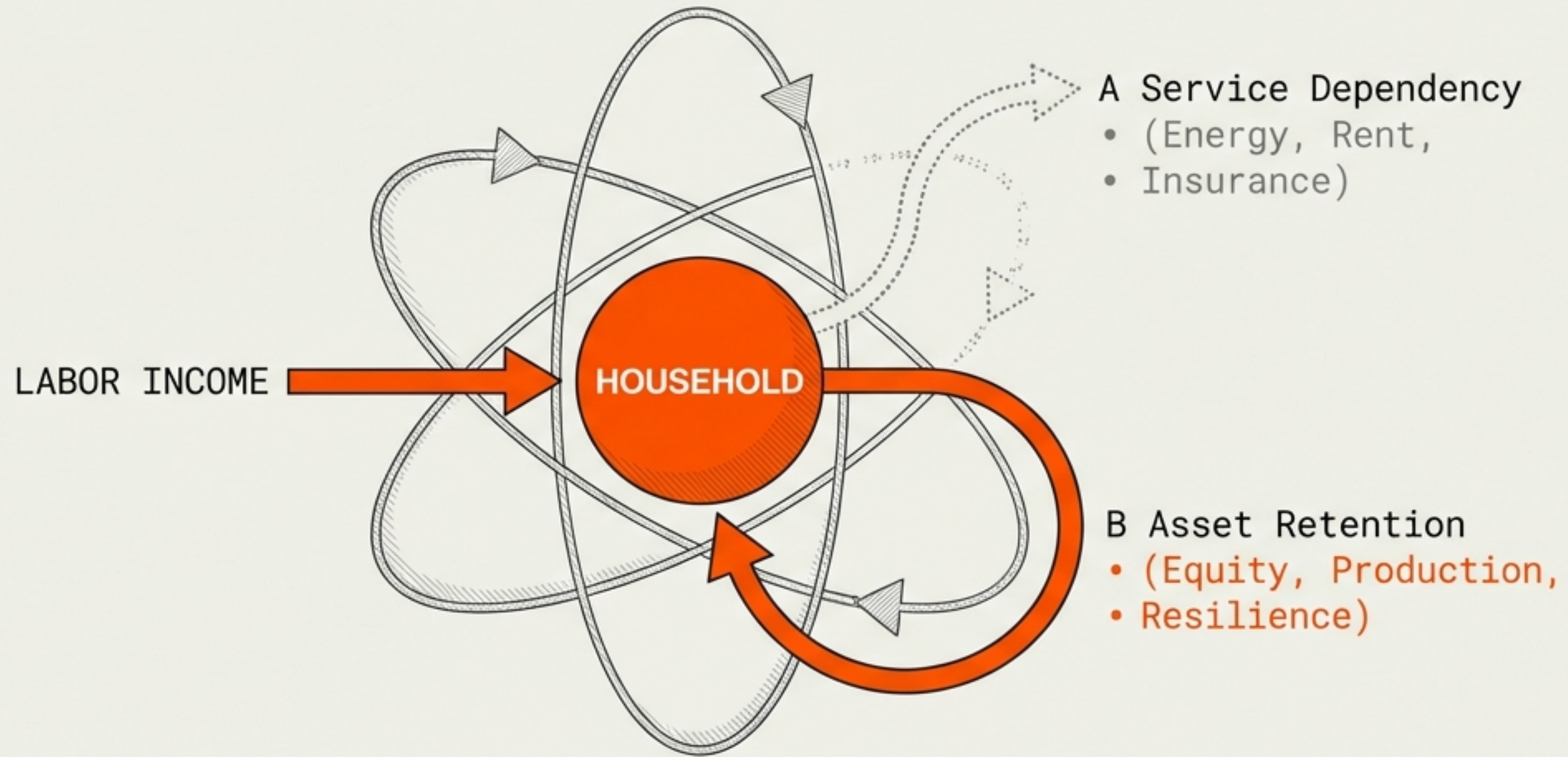


YHAUZ (ASSET)



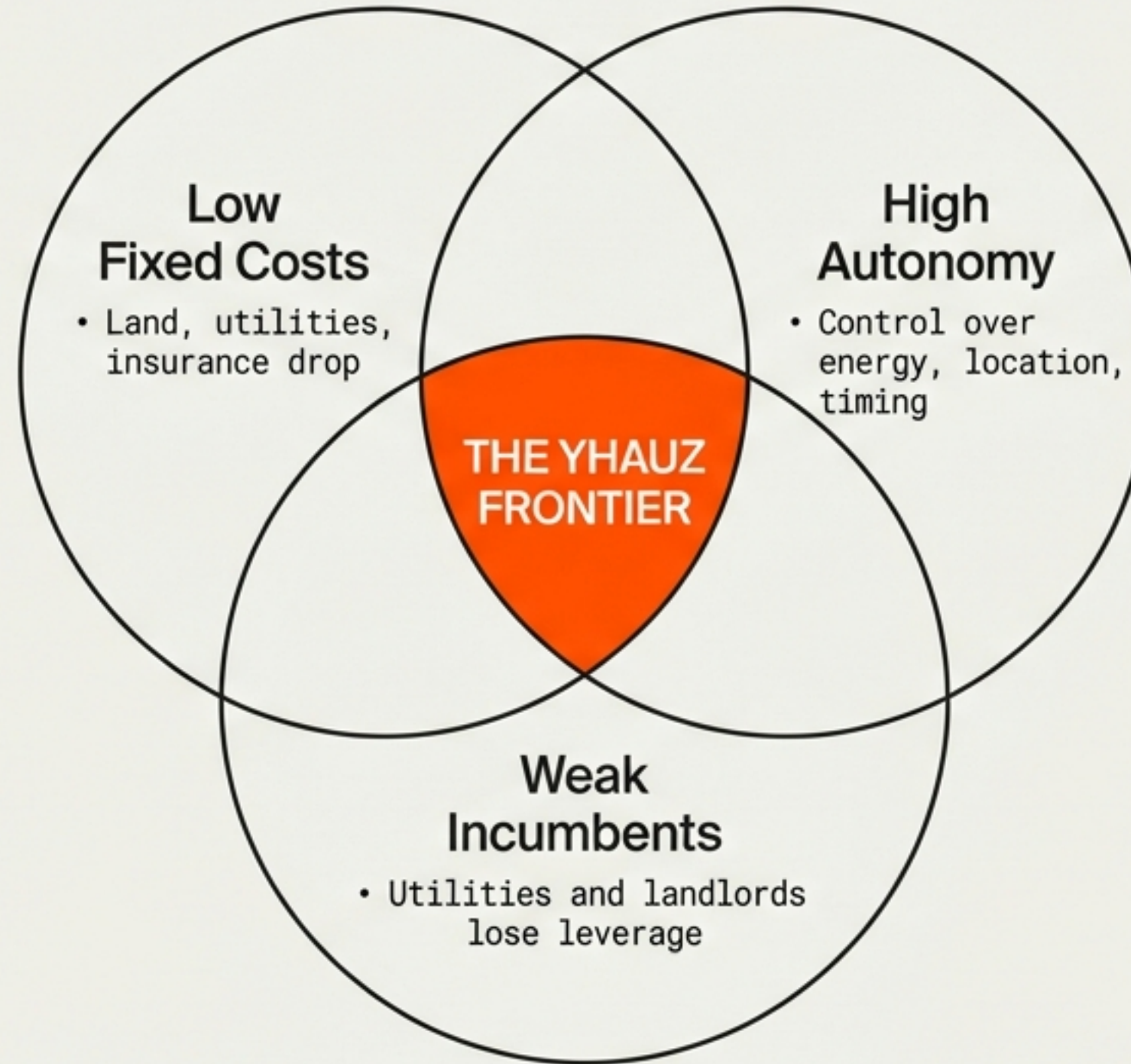
- **No Utility Monopolies:** Zero exposure to escalating fees.
- **No Time Risk:** Bypass grid capacity constraints.
- **No Service Subscription:** Removes the primary monthly cash bleed.

Repairing Economics at the Source



The household is the Atomic Unit of the economy. Currently, households function as pure labor inputs where income bleeds into service dependencies. YHauz intervenes at this atomic level, converting households into micro-balance sheets with productive assets.

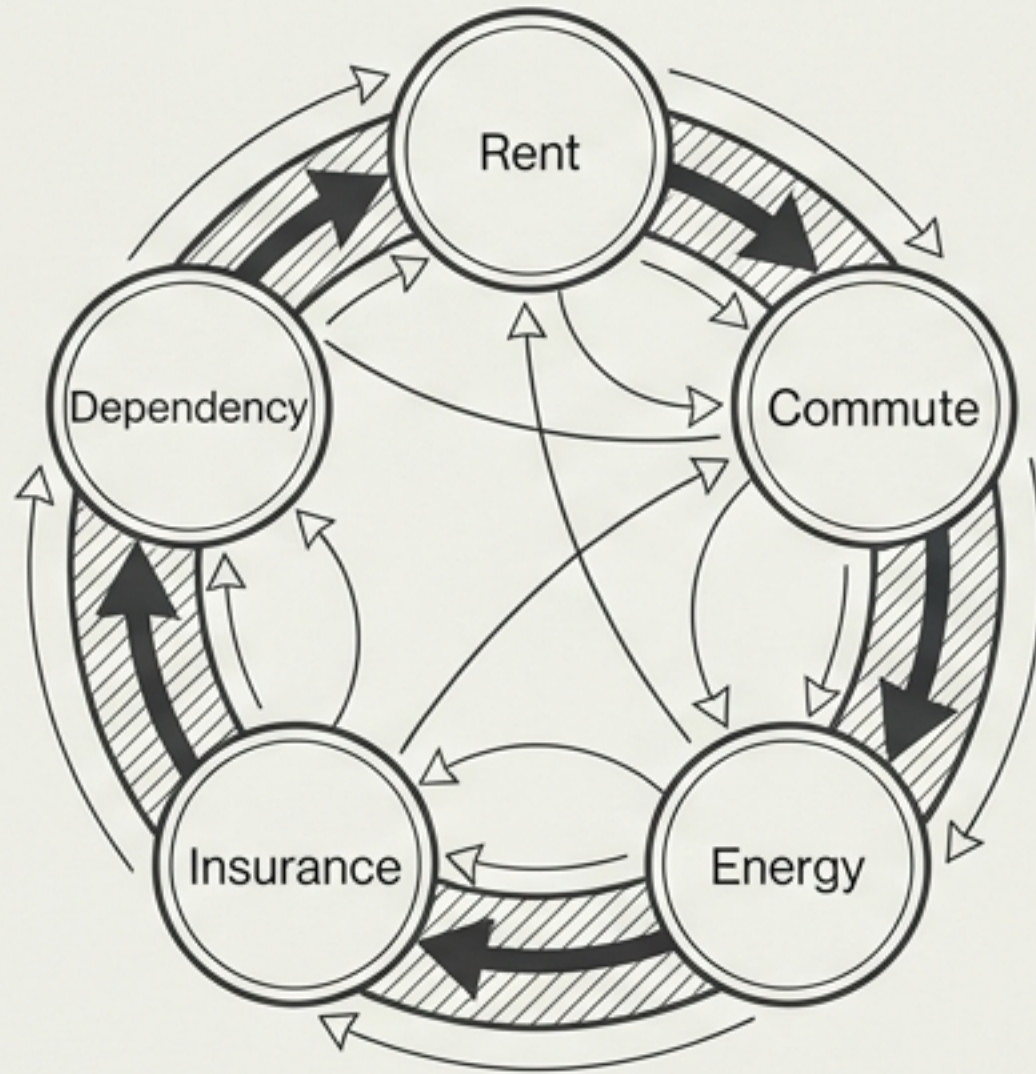
Where the Model Works: The Frontier Definition



A frontier exists only when these three conditions align.
This alignment opens territory that was previously economically unusable.

THE SOVEREIGN LOOP (PRODUCTION)



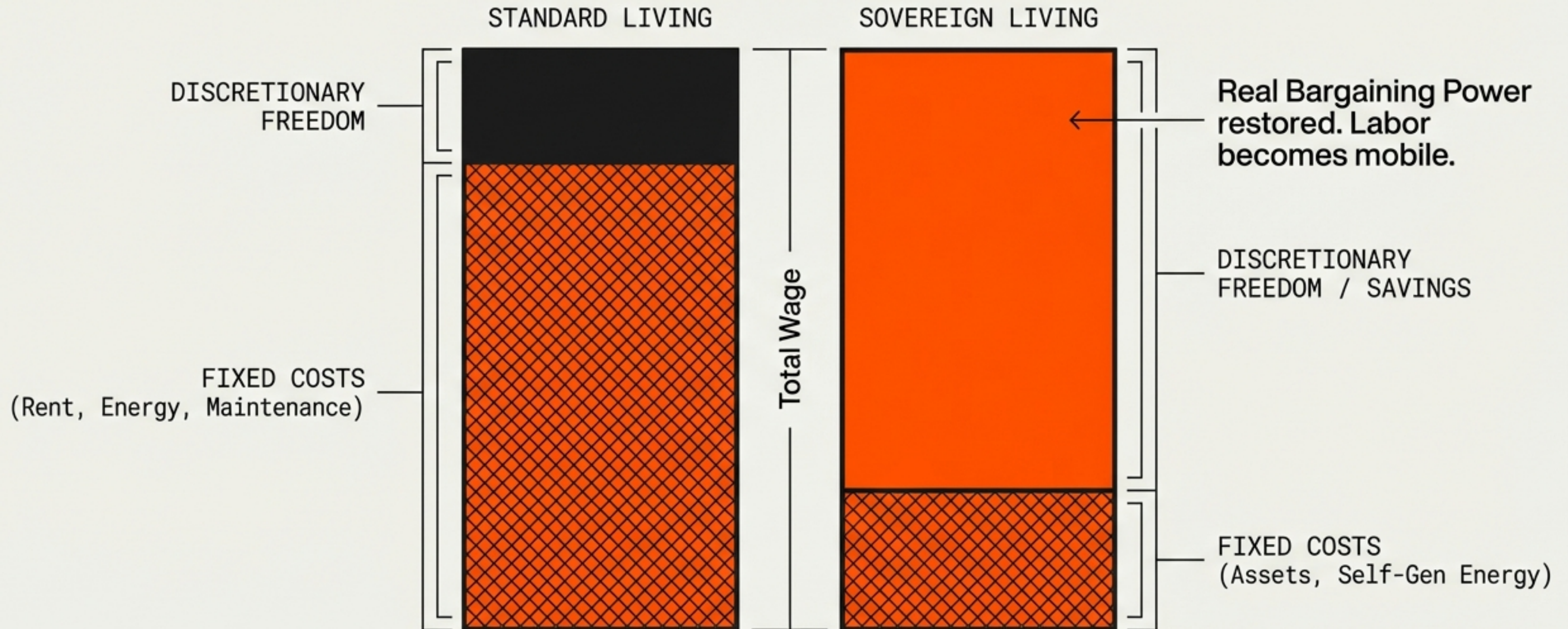
YHauz breaks the urban rent extraction loop. It enables exurban siting, lowers land costs, and shrinks exposure to regulated monopolies.

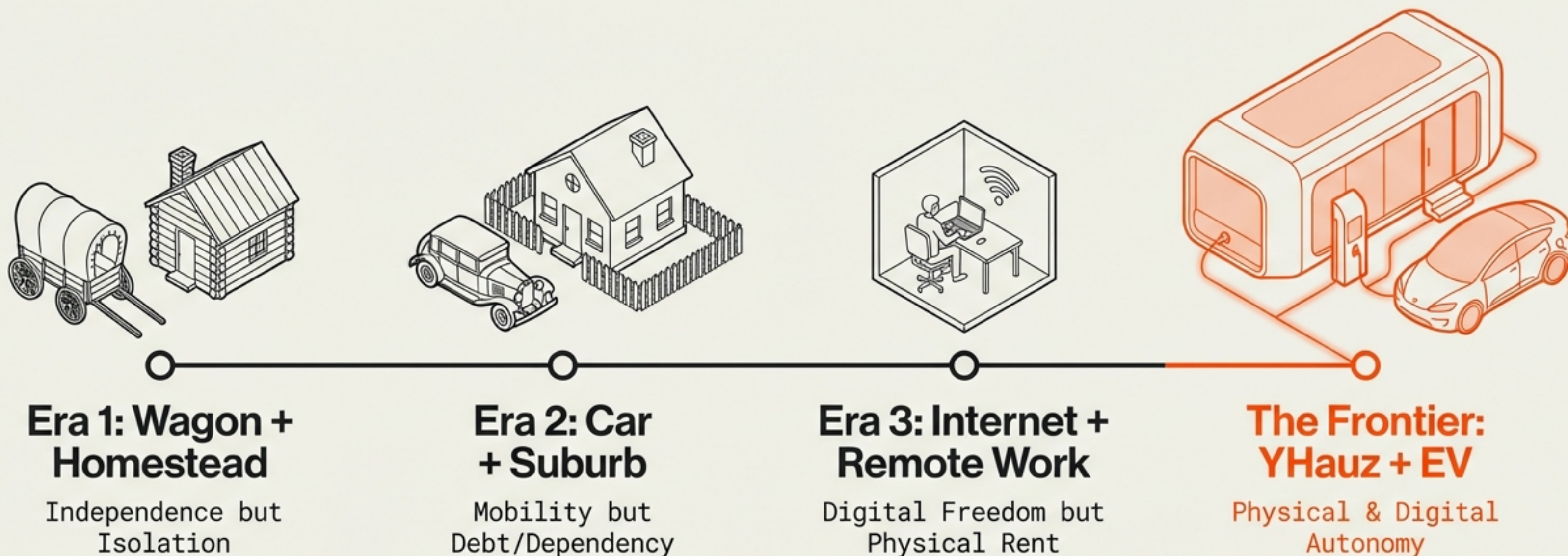

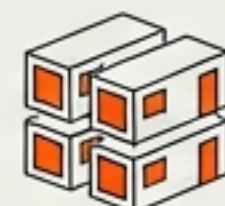

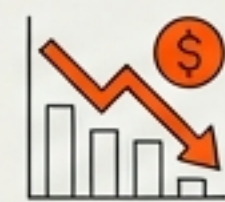

The Quiet Macro Effect



As households own land and self-provision essentials:

1. Wage pressure eases without lowering living standards.
2. GDP composition shifts from rent-heavy services to capital-light production.
